Please continue to check our calendar and your child's classroom newsletter for any upcoming trips.

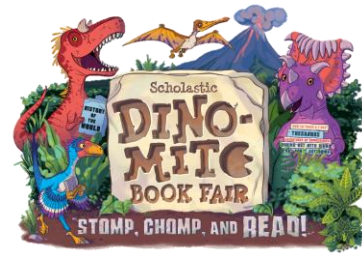


Picking students up early from school just before the dismissal bell is becoming very challenging!
